All parents will be scheduled a conference with their child(ren)'s homeroom teacher in September, November and possibly at the end of February. The September conferences are "teacher listening conferences" where our teachers will be ready to listen to you tell about your child(ren) . We want to learn as much as possible about your child as they begin the new school year. In November, each teacher will see the parent(s) of every child to review evidence of how the child is meeting the grade level expectations. The February conferences will be as requested by teacher or parent.

Progress reports will be sent home mid-way of each quarter for those students who are not making satisfactory progress in one or more subject areas. As a teacher choice, some teachers will send progress reports to all students .

It is our professional belief that we are here to discuss a child's educational progress at anytime a parent or we, as educators, feel there is a reason to communicate. We believe strongly that open and often communication is in the best educational interests of the child. Do not wait for a scheduled conference. Please call your child's teacher whenever you have questions or concerns.

***Conferences are for questions, concerns, or just a time to communicate! We need you to attend. It is one of the most important things you can do for your child. We strive to see each and every child's parent(s) at the scheduled conferences. Won't you help us by attending?***
