WHO MAY ENROLL IN SUMMER SCHOOL CLASSES?

The School District of Waukesha Summer School is open to all public, private and parochial students on a voluntary basis. Enrollees must not have graduated from high school and must be legal residents of the district. Students not living in the district may enroll if room permits and upon payment of tuition.

GENERAL SUMMER SCHOOL INFORMATION

- High School Summer School will take place at **North High School** from **June 21st through July 23rd**.
- Students must provide their own transportation to and from summer school.
- **Registration for high school courses will be held in the guidance office at each high school from March 1st through March 26th, 2010. Late registrations for 2nd Sem. failures is June 9th - June 16th in room 219 at the Lindholm building from 8-noon.**
- **There will be no classes on Monday, July 5th.**
- Only one student per registration form. Additional forms are available from any school guidance office.
- Parent or guardian must sign the registration form if the student is under age 18.
- Confirmation of classes will be mailed home the first week of June.
- High school courses are intended for students that have failed the course and need to make up the credit.
- **NO REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED.**

ATTENDANCE

Due to the length of summer school, classes are condensed. If a student misses a session(s) it is difficult to catch up and is disruptive for the other students. One day of absence at the high school level is equal to three days absence during the regular school year. **Therefore, high school students who have three absences will be dropped from the course.** Please plan vacations and other absences so your child will not miss his/her summer school classes. If a student needs to be absent due to illness, doctors' and dentists' appointments, and unexpected emergency situations, please call the summer school office. Give the student's name, class he/she will miss, and the reason for the absence.

CONDUCT

Students are expected to follow the same standards of conduct in effect during the regular school year. Individual schools may inform students of additional expectations. Disciplinary action may include but is not limited to: detention, student/parent conferences, suspension, and expulsion. Days missed for disciplinary reasons will be counted as an absence. Students may not loiter on private property near the school, and may be subject to ticketing.

DRESS

Students should wear appropriate dress during the summer session. It is expected that clothing be neat, clean and appropriate for school purposes. Students must wear shoes. Headgear is not allowed.
