Waukesha West opened at the beginning of the 1993-1994 school year with over 100 classrooms and labs, an impressive co-curricular complex with more than 55 acres of space that includes a football stadium with an 8-lane track, 2 baseball fields, two softball fields, two soccer fields, eight tennis courts, a fieldhouse, a natatorium, and numerous practice fields to service West's 1300 students and many co-curricular offerings.

West High School has compiled significant accolades during its 17 years of existence for both academic and co-curricular excellence and is an NCA accredited institution. We offer a consistent, rich, varied and rigorous curriculum that is aligned with 21st century standards. More than 75% of our students who take AP courses annually earn college credit and the average ACT score of a West student is 23.5, well above the national average of 21.1.

West's Academic Decathlon team has won 10 straight state championships and has garnered national recognition 10 years running. Over the past 17 years West has won 38 state championships and 59 Classic 8 conference championships. Within the last year, West had 1 state championship team, individual state champions in different sports, 2 Classic 8 conference championships, 4 teams qualify for national recognition, and significant individual and team recognition on the regional, sectional, state and national levels.
