Fifteen Years of Excellence

Waukesha West had its genesis with the community's approval for a \$36 million referendum for several district projects on April 3, 1990. West opened in the beginning of the 1993-1994 school year with over 100 classrooms, an impressive co-curricular complex with over 55 acres of space that includes a football stadium with an 8-lane track, 2 baseball fields, two soft-ball fields, two soccer fields, eight tennis courts, a fieldhouse, a natatorium, and numerous practice fields to service West's 1500 students and many co-curricular offerings.

West High School has compiled significant accolades during its initial 15 years of existence. The average ACT score of a West student is 23.3, well above the national average of 21.2. West's Academic Decathlon team has won 6 straight state championships and has garnered national recognition 7 years running. Numerous West co-curricular activities receive conference, state, and national acknowledgment on a yearly basis. Over the past 15 years, West had won 21 state championships and 42 Classic 8 conference championships. Last year, West had 2 state championship teams and 4 teams qualify for national recognition.
